

## **Parking at the Exhibition Centre**

Camper/Bus: SOUTH 1

### **PARKING**

Choose the car park that is most convenient for you, approach the entrance column so that your number plate can be read, collect your ticket, wait for the barrier to open and enter.

### **HOW AND WHERE TO PAY**

Pay at the parking ticket machines (cash, debit, credit cards), those with operators are at the SOUTH entrance. If you need an INVOICE, ask the operator at the time of payment.

After paying for your parking, collect your vehicle, approach the exit barrier of the car park: the barrier will open automatically when your number plate is read. Keep your exit ticket (to be used only in the event of problems reading your number plate).

### **PARKING WITH TELEPASS**

In SUD car parks 1-3 you can park by paying automatically with your Telepass device.

Please note: if you have a Parking Pass, deactivate or shield your Telepass device. In the absence of number plate recognition, the Telepass system will detect the presence of your device and charge you for parking.

### **SHORT STOP**

Accompanying someone? For you, 5 minutes free parking in all our car parks.

### **CAR PARKS FOR PASSENGERS WITH REDUCED MOBILITY**

In the Station, SUD 1-3 car parks there are parking spaces reserved for customers with reduced mobility.

In order to use the free car park, before leaving with your vehicle, you must go to the Car Park Tills with Operator by showing

- Ticket collected at the car park entrance;
- Valid European Presidential Decree 151/2012 badge.

The operator will validate the ticket to be used at the exit.

Attention: if you have a Telepass device on board, remember to deactivate or screen it so that, when entering one of the car parks where the system is enabled, you will not be charged for parking.

### **CHARGING STATIONS FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLES**

Rimini Fiera offers its car park customers a free charging service for electric vehicles.

In the SUD 1 car park there are 6 charging stations for electric vehicles, for a total of 12 sockets.

The sockets are Type 2 with Recharge Mode 3, recharging with power up to 11kw for each socket The columns are active H24, during the events (including set-up and dismantling) Recharging can be activated manually by the user without the use of dedicated cards, badges or APPs There is no connection cable between the station and the vehicle, the cable must be the user's The service is only on availability of space
